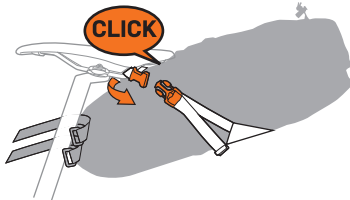


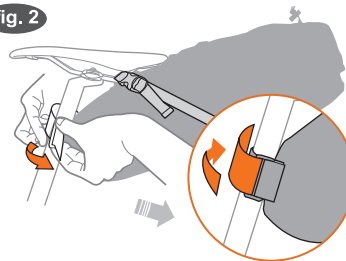

Thread saddle attachment strap through left saddle rail, then fasten buckle. Repeat for right side. Adjust straps so bag fits snugly under the saddle (see fig. 1).

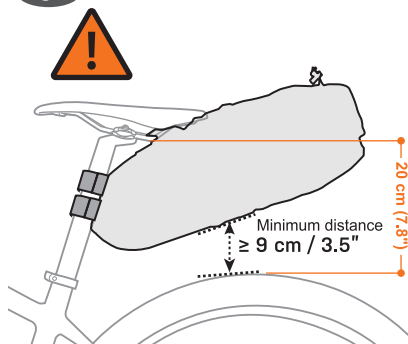
Wrap both Velcro straps around seatpost. Adjust straps so front of bag is tight against seatpost (see fig. 2).

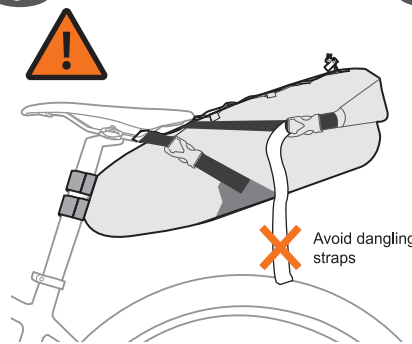
Roll bag opening tightly 3 turns in a clockwise direction, then fasten left and right side buckles. Adjust strap length according to the load carried (see fig. 3). For waterproofness, bag must be rolled up at least three turns.

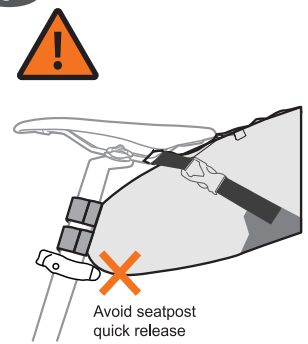
Minimum distance between bottom of bag and top of tyre is 9 cm (3.5") (see fig. 4).

Before using, ensure there are no dangling straps. Do not carry small items in bungee cords, or items that will fall out. Ensure anything carried in bungee cords is firmly attached (see fig. 5).

Ensure bag or straps do not touch or interfere with seatpost quick release lever (see fig. 6).
